## ***Lil Eagles*** – (Ages 5 to 7 year olds) Beginner Soccer

Players can sign up for 90 minutes of fun that will introduce each child to games challenging them in thinking, balance, agility, coordination and multitasking.

Activities involve, but are not always limited to using a ball. This is called the Romantic stage in a soccer players career. Each session is 90 minutes for five days.

(All get a ball and a t-shirt. Space is limited for this age group!)

**Rising Eagles** - (Ages 7–11 year olds) Players will have a chance to laugh and play while participating in the greatest game in the world. “SOCCER”

These player border the romantic stage and the technical stage. Players will improve technical skills with many repetitions and use these skills in structured activities and games.

Our goal here is to build confidence with the ball so players can focus on playing and not trying to find the ball. (Space is limited at this age group)

**Soaring Eagles** - (Ages 12–14 year olds ) All players will be able to experience the same activities as players will be matched up with other players with like abilities allowing them to compete with more confidence.

In this technical to mature stage each player will be given more repetitions with the ball to instill more comfort with the ball. Here we add pressure in game like situations and the players enjoy taking on each task given to them through different games.

The most competitive players who have reached the mature stage, possibly getting ready for high school soccer have multiple reasons for going to camp. From a technical tune up to beginning fitness training for the fall.

Everyday will have a match condition from 1v1 to team play for realistic pressure with the ball. Small group tactics are incorporated into each session and end with putting these ideas into full team play.
