PLAYER/COACH/SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents and Spectators should:

- Remember that children have more need of praise than criticism. Let them have fun and enjoy the game.
- Never instruct players on the field.
- Teach sportsmanship. Parents, coaches, or players are not allowed to show disrespect to referees, to other players, or to other coaches. Violation of this rule may result in expulsion from the Club and/or banishment from attending games.
- Attempt to relieve the pressure of competition, not increase it.
- Be supportive of the coach. The coach is a volunteer giving of personal time and money to provide a recreational activity for your child.
- Remember opponents are necessary friends – without them, your child could not participate.
- Applaud good play by your team and by members of the opposing team.
- Never question an official's judgment or honesty. Officials are symbols of fair play, integrity and sportsmanship.
- Accept the results of each game. Encourage your child to be gracious in victory, and turn defeat into victory by working towards improvement.
